1. **AROMATIC** - Bruno Andreu - 2019 - VIN DE PAYS D'OC - FRANCE £ 8.99
Characteristics: a lively elegant wine, offering aromas of passion fruit and great freshness on the finish.
2. **SILENI ESTATES** - Marlborough - 2019 NEW ZEALAND £11.75
Characteristics: Zesty citrus tinged with ripe tropical and gooseberry fruit flavours, lingering finish and impeccable balance.
Reminds you what made Marlborough Sauvignon blanc famous!
3. **TOURAINE**- Jean Francois Roy - 2019 FRANCE £13.95
Characteristics: from the Canton of Valançais, the wine grows on red and yellow clay. Dry and supple, you will find the lemon and grapefruit flavours long on the finish.
4. **LAWSON'S DRY HILLS** - Marlborough - 2019 NEW ZEALAND £16.95
Characteristics: Wonderful aromatic wine which offers a tempting combination of passion and citrus fruit with a slight herbaceous edge. Fresh, juicy and moreish with lovely weight and texture.
5. **SANCERRE** - Cuvée les Caillottes, Jean Max Roger - 2019 FRANCE £23.75
Characteristics: Top quality Sauvignon! A fresh white wine, full of flavours.

Chardonnay

6. **AROMATIC** - Bruno Andreu - Vin de Pays d'Oc - 2018 FRANCE £ 8.99
Characteristics: refreshing, well balanced with aromas of pear and vanilla and a generous, harmonious finish.
7. **WENTE** – Morning Fog, Livermore Valley – 2018 California USA £17.75
Characteristics: this chardonnay burst with aromatics from citrus, lemon curd, pear and toasty oak. This wine hints of vanilla and citrus on the palate, finishing with a nice acidity.
8. **SAINT VERAN** – Domaine Gueugnon Remon – 2018 FRANCE £17.50
Characteristics: lovely fruit and weight with a long finish. Very elegant!
9. **CHABLIS** - Domaine du Chardonnay, Moulin du Patis - 2018 FRANCE £19.95
Characteristics: the south facing vineyard produces fully ripe grapes resulting in a powerful wine. Part vinify in barrel to give a toasted nuance to the creamy rich fruit, making a distinctive slightly oaky style Chablis.

CHARDONNAY

10. **SAINT-AUBIN**, Domaine Langoureau – Côtes de Beaune – 2018 FRANCE £25.00
Characteristics: attractive golden shiny appearance with deep yellow tints. The nose is open, slightly toasted and very mature with a touch of red fruit aromas. The dominating aromas centre around spices and white fruit. Palate is rich, very round, buttery with a beautiful length.
11. **POUILLY-FUISSÉ** – Vieilles vignes, Denis Jeandeau – 2019 FRANCE £34.00
Characteristics: these 55 years old vines are cultivated on clay and limestone soils. This wine reveals rich aromas and salty notes. Absolutely delicious, sold in all the top restaurant in Paris!
12. **MEURSAULT** - DOMAINE Dupont Fahn – Les Vireuils – 2018 FRANCE £48.00
Characteristics: opulent and fruity but with great finesse on the palate
13. **PULIGNY-MONTRACHET** – 1er Cru la Garenne – 2018 FRANCE £60.00
Domaine Sylvain Langoureau
Characteristics: At first the nose is discreet. It then opens up very quickly, a sign of good ageing potential. By contrast the palate is lively, ample, racy and very long. Can be kept up to 7 years.

VIOGNIER

14. **ESPRIT BARVILLE** – BROTTÉ- Châteauneuf du Pape – 2019 FRANCE £11.75
Characteristics: Maison Brotte produces exceptional wine from the Rhone Valley by respecting the character of each terroir. Great white wine full of sun and flavour.
15. **CONDRIEU** – Los Cheze – Pagus Luminis – 2018 FRANCE £36.00
Characteristics: The vines are 20 years old on granite soil. Apricot and peaches with a spicy richness

MISCELLANEOUS GRAPES

16. **PICPOUL DE PINET** – Duc de Morny, L'Ormarine – 2019 FRANCE £12.60
Grape variety: Piquepoul
Characteristics: near the Méditerranée in full sun, this Picpoul has a soft, delicate nose with pleasant note of acacia, delicate and and fresh in the mouth. Goes well with fish and shellfish.
17. **VOUVRAY DE GAUTIER** - Benoit Gautier - Vin de Loire - 2017 FRANCE £17.25
Grape variety: Chenin Blanc
Characteristics: classic flavours of acacia, straw, honey and citrus. A delicious acidic white wine from the Loire Valley.
18. **GEWURZTRAMINER** - Trapet- 2019 Riquewihr - ALSACE FRANCE £21.95
Grape variety: Traminer Rosé
Characteristics: due to the soil containing lots of quartz stone this Gewurztraminer is harmonious and distinctive. It has rich rosé aromas and aromatic palate. Slightly sweet wine!

19. **CÔTES DE PROVENCE**, Le Villages - 2019 FRANCE £12.85
Les maitres vigneronns de la Presqu'île de Saint-Tropez
Characteristics: Strawberry and floral flavours, dry and light bodied.
20. **LES AGASSES** - Val Joanis - 2019 FRANCE £13.20
Characteristics: the grapes are harvested by night to ensure they deliver the very freshness of citrus fruit and red berry flavours.
21. **CHATEAU VAL-JOANIS** - Luberon - 2019 FRANCE £18.00
Grapes are mainly Syrah with 10% Grenache and 10% Cinsault.
Characteristics: strawberry and floral flavours, dry, fresh and light bodied.

RED WINE

22. **MOUNTAIN RANGE** - Concha Y Toro, Central Valley – 2018 CHILE £ 8.99
Characteristics: Medium bodied, plum, cherry and berry fruit flavours with a touch of spice, unoaked.
23. **AROMATIC** - Bruno Andreu- Vin de Pays d'Oc - 2018 FRANCE £ 8.99
Characteristics: intense aroma of ripe berry. Elegant and soft with a round and silky finish.
24. **CHÂTEAU GARREAU** - Bordeaux Supérieur- 2016 FRANCE £14.95
Characteristics: another excellent Bordeaux from Alain Thienot cellars, vibrant and elegant.
25. **CHÂTEAU LA FLEUR GOUJON** - Lalande-de-Pommerol - 2018 FRANCE £15.25
Grape variety: 90% Merlot 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
Characteristics: with a deep ruby colour, this wine has an intense and elegant nose of fresh red berries and spices. On the palate, the whole is balanced with velvety tannins.

26. **CHÂTEAU DE RICAUD** - Réserve des Côteaux, Cadillac - 2015 FRANCE £17.75
Characteristics: beautifully developed, garnet red in colour, well balanced fruit and oak, smooth and fleshy on the palate with perfectly integrated tannins. One of the best Petit Chateau wine in the premieres Cotes.
27. **CHÂTEAU RAHOUL**, Graves, vignoble Dourthe - 2015 FRANCE £28.75
Characteristics: the colour is dark and deep. Very rich and full body. strong and elegant tannins. Red fruits aromas, strawberry, cherry with spicy and oak notes.
28. **CHÂTEAU LE BOSQ**, Saint Estephe, Cru Bourgeois – 2012 FRANCE £38.00
Characteristics: very ripe, offering black fruits, cedar and cinnamon. rewarding velvety textures with some complexity.
29. **CHÂTEAU GRAND BARRAIL** – 2014 FRANCE £36.45
LA MARZELLE LE GIGEAC – St Emilion Grand Cru – Vignobles Dourthe
Characteristics: very deep ruby red in appearance with intense complex aromas of violets and red berry fruits combine with hints of spice and liquorice. Silky tannins add a lovely structure to the wine.
30. **CHÂTEAU BELGRAVE**, Haut Médoc - 2012 FRANCE £43.95
Grand Cru Classé – Vignobles Dourthe
Characteristics: deep and concentrated in appearance. Dark fruit aromas of blackberry, woods and mint enhanced with s subtle Mocha note. Initially velvety on the palate the wine gains in body with the very delicate and silky tannins adding structure. this wine is well balance, fresh and elegant until the lingering finish.
32. **CHATEAU DE RICAUD**, Grand vin de Bordeaux – 2015 FRANCE £24.75
Cadillac Cotes de Bordeaux
Characteristics: deep, intense colour. This wine has a focused detailed bouquet with crisp blackberry and briary scents, a touch of cedar in the background. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, good depth and freshness with a sappy, harmonious finish that has really blossomed in barrel.

Pinot noir

33. **LAWSON'S DRY HILLS** – Marlborough – 2017 NEW ZEALAND £20.95
Characteristics: Expressive wine with intense berry fruits, lovely texture, great concentration & gentle tannin.
34. **BOURGOGNE**, Jean-Marc Pillot – 2017 FRANCE £19.95
Characteristics: plenty of soft ripe blackberry, cherry and raspberry fruit with a touch of earth and leather.
35. **NUITS-ST-GEORGES**, Domaine Daniel Rion & Fils – 2017 FRANCE £50.00
Vieilles vignes. Characteristics: dark, meaty flavours of black cherry, blackcurrant, earth and tar mark, dense red. The ripe fruit is supported by a vibrant structure. Balanced and long overall.
36. **VOSNE-ROMANÉE VILLAGE**, Domaine Daniel Rion & fils – 2016 FRANCE £70.00
Appellation Vosne-Romanée contrôlée
Characteristics: Scents of cherry and rose, this wine becomes complex with age, with a nose of underwood, autumn leaves and mushrooms. Its tannins are discrete and consistent, but always elegant.
37. **GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN**, 1er Cru Lavaux St Jacques – 2015 FRANCE £85.00
Characteristics: this 1er Cru reveals aromas of res fruits with a full, round and well-structure palate.
Keep from 8 to 15 years!

38. **MORGON LES CHARMES**, Domaine de Bel-Air – 2017 FRANCE £18.75
Marc Lafont
Characteristics: this wine has perfume of roses, lilacs and jasmine with elegance and good tannin.

Syrah

40. **CROZES-HERMITAGE** – Domaine des Entrefaux – 2017 FRANCE £25.00
Charles & Francois Tardy,
Characteristics: organically farmed in Chanos-Curson, Northern Rhône. This wine is rich and intense. Its brooding, perfumed mix of dark fruits and meaty, smoky savour is great now but will continue to blossom over the next decade into something unbelievably good...

Syrah, Grenache, Mourvêdre & Cinsaults

41. **CHÂTEAU DE BORD**, Brotte, Châteauneuf-du-Pape – 2017 FRANCE £12.75
Characteristics: Dark ruby colour. Aromas of dark fruits, violets and cedar, ending on notes of thyme and coffee beans. Ample and elegant with apparent yet soft tannins. Flavours of wild berries and black cherries. The finale on the palate is remarkably long.
42. **GIGONDAS**, Domaine Grand Romane, Pierre Amadieu 2016 FRANCE £24.95
Characteristics: on the nose there are aromas of black fruit and red fruits, stewed with a hint of vanilla meet savoury notes of thyme, laurel and black olives on the palate. Powerful tannins fill the mouth with notes of spicy liquorice and pepper for a long and satisfying finish. An astonishing balance of complexity, power and elegance.

Malbec

43. **QUARA SPECIAL SELECTION** – 2018 ARGENTINA £14.95
Characteristics: intense red colour with purple flashes. In the nose, Fruity aromas, with subtle notes of plum, black pepper and spices, Result from the gentle rest in oak barrels.
Structure in the palate, with full bodied and round tannins.
This Malbec is balanced and elegant.
44. **HUNUC MALBEC** – ORGANIC - 2019 – CHILE £17.45
Tupungato, Alto Gualtallary Valley by the foothills of the Andes at 4000 ft. altitude.
Characteristics: intense violet colour. Red and black fruits, figs and Berries aromas. Medium body and round velvety tannins.

45. **SEMELE**, Crianza – Ribera del Duero – 2017 SPAIN £16.95
Characteristics: Deep cherry colour. Red fruit and spices on the nose. Fresh, round, full, lots of red fruit aromas. Great ageing potential!
46. **VS MURUA** Rioja - 2017 SPAIN £17.95
Characteristics: this wine has freshness, elegance & a good personality
47. **MURUA RESERVA** Rioja - 2012 SPAIN £19.95
Characteristics: Red, savoury and classic, a beautiful Rioja

- 48.. **PROSECCO ZONIN**, Special Cuvée – NV ITALY £10.50
Grapes variety: Glera
Characteristics: Bright pale straw yellow, a fine clear mousse very well-balanced of wisteria flowers and Rennet apples.
49. **CASTELLBLANCH** – Carat Brut – Cava NV SPAIN £12.50
Grape variety: 40% Xarel, 30% Macabeo, 30% Parellada
Characteristics: ageing 12 to 18 months in the bottle. On the nose it is rich and intense, and shows the aromas of a young Cava with a classic blend – fruity aromas with a pleasant citrus fruit background. This is a light and fresh extra dry Cava with a nice smooth finish.

50. **ALAIN THIENOT** – NV – FRANCE £33.00
Pinot noir & Chardonnay
Characteristics: Biscuity, ripe and beautifully balanced.
51. **BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE** – NV – FRANCE £40.00
Pinot noir & Chardonnay
Characteristics: The champagne of 007, what more can you say!!
52. **VEUVE CLICQUOT** – NV – FRANCE £49.00
Pinot noir & Chardonnay
Characteristics: Elegant and powerful.
53. **ALAIN THIENOT ROSÉ** – Brut champagne – NV – FRANCE £54.00
Characteristics: another good, dry and beautifully balanced Champagne from Alain Thienot. The Ladies' favourite!!!
54. **DOM PÉRIGNON** – Brut champagne – 2008 FRANCE £140.00
Characteristics: one of the best champagnes. Beautifully balanced and harmonious, the 2008 Dom Pérignon is rich, voluptuous and creamy.
55. **ALAIN THIENOT BLANC DE BLANC** – NV - FRANCE £40.00
100% Chardonnay.
Characteristics: light and bright yellow. The nose is dominated By notes of lemon and orange blossom, typical of great chardonnays. Elegant and generous wine
56. **ALAIN THIENOT BRUT MILLEISMÉ** - 2008 FRANCE £42.00
40% chardonnay, 40% Pinot Meunier, 20% Pinot noir.
Characteristics: shimmering golden yellow. Notes of toasted And roasted almonds. The aromas of baked lemon meringue Reveal a beautiful freshness and long satisfying on the palate

57. **RUSTENBERG**, Straw wine – 2018 SOUTH AFRICA 375ml bottle £13.00
Characteristics: blend of Chenin Blanc and Viognier grapes dried on straw to concentrate their natural flavour, acidity and sugar before fermented. This wine lusciously sweet still bright, fresh and complex with aromas and flavours of dried apricot, ripe pear, orange peel and honey
58. **ELYSIUM**, California black Muscat – 2016 USA 375ml £16.75
Characteristics: Elysium in Greek Mythology is paradise! The provocative rose and litchi aroma of Elysium resonates from the black Muscat grape variety. Sweet and delicious!!
59. **ROYAL TOKAKI**, latest harvest – 2015 – HUNGARY 500ml £18.45
Characteristics: bright golden colour, beautifully fresh, peachy nose with great purity. Rich, however slightly sweet palate with fresh juicy white fruits flavours. Mineral finish with elegant bitterness, great balance and harmony.
60. **ESSENSIA**, CALIFORNIA ORANGE MUSCAT 375ml £15.25
2015 – USA
Characteristics: The distinctive flavour of Essensia wine is derived from the Orange Muscat grape. The variety of grape has characteristics of oranges.
61. **MUSCAT** – Domaine Lerys – Muscat de Rive Saltes NV FRANCE 500ml £21.50
100% Muscat Petits Grains grapes
Characteristics: pale yellow colour with green highlights. The nose is an explosive mixture of fruit and white flowers. Soft, very fruity & well balanced on the palate.
62. **CHATEAU DE RICAUD** – Loupiac – 2015 FRANCE 750ml £21.50
This sweet wine is made with Semillon grapes.
It is fruity, summery and fleshy.
63. **CASTELANAU DE SUDUIRAUT** - Sauternes - 2009 FRANCE 750ml £39.95
Mainly Semillon grapes.
Characteristics: Beautiful golden robe! Expressive nose. Sauterne at its best!!!
64. **MONTBAZILLAC** – Domaine de Grange Neuve – 2016 FRANCE 500ml £15.75
Mainly Semillon grapes.
Characteristics: fabulous dessert wine, sweet and luscious with great backbone of fine acidity for a clean finish. The nose is fresh. Flavours on the palate are richer, honey with a finishing touch of bitter orange.
